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#### **Preamble**

The Performance Agreement is entered into between the Secretary and Director, Department Of Medical Supplies And Health Infrastructure.

The objectives of this Performance Agreement are:

- a) To establish clarity and consensus about annual priorities for the Department Of Medical Supplies And Health Infrastructure consistent with the o11th Five Year Plan of the Ministry, and Government's other priorities;
- b) To provide an objective and fair basis for evaluating the overall performance of the Department Of Medical Supplies And Health Infrastructure at the end of the financial year

The Performance Agreement represents an important accountability mechanism for inculcating a performance based culture at all levels of government.

THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:
