Notification


The Ministry of Health (MoH) has received reports of individuals and entities operating private healthcare centres and premises without the required approval or licenses from the relevant authorities.

As per Section 47 of the Healthcare Services Rules and Regulations (HSRR) 2025, no person or entity is permitted to provide healthcare services without prior authorisation from the MoH.

The Ministry hereby reminds the public and all concerned that:

- No individual or entity shall operate any healthcare centre or premises without obtaining technical authorisation from the MoH;
- Any person or entity currently operating an unlicensed and unauthorised healthcare centre to immediately cease operations. Failure to comply will result in regulatory action, including prosecution, as per the HSRR;
- Members of the public are strongly advised to seek healthcare services only from licensed and authorised centres; and
- Any suspected cases of illegal or unlicensed healthcare providers may be reported to the Ministry of Health at 17481763 during office hours.

This notification is issued in the interest of public safety and well-being.
