The deadline for submission of the English Proficiency Certificate (IELTS/TOEFL/Duolingo) will be communicated via email after receiving confirmation from the Embassy of Japan, New Delhi, India.

Applicants to the Master of Healthcare Administration program at Nagoya University are not required to submit an essay, as stated in the Note Verbale/Application Guidelines.

Important note:

- 1. First screening by the recommending authorities of each country (Shortlisting);
- 2. Second screening by host university based on application documents;
- 3. Third screening through interviews of candidates, conducted by faculty members of host university;
- 4. Primary selection based on total scores of the second and third screenings along with comments of Interviewers; and
- 5. Final selection by the YLP committee established by MEXT.
