Registration for sensitisation and training on infection prevention, hygiene and safe practice

The Department of Health Services, Ministry of Health, hereby invites owners, managers, and operators of tattoo studios, body piercing establishments, beauty parlours, wellness centres, massage centres, and other similar personal care service establishments across the country to register for an upcoming sensitisation and training programme on hygiene, infection prevention and control (IPC), and public health requirements.

This training aims to strengthen awareness and compliance with national health standards and regulatory requirements, with the objective of safeguarding the health and safety of clients, workers, and the general public.

The programme will focus on key areas including hygiene practices, IPC measures, waste management, occupational health and safety, and other relevant public health obligations for personal care service establishments. These requirements are aligned with the Healthcare Services Rules and Regulations (HSRR) 2025, particularly for services classified under Category IX (Other Services).

Registration details

Eligible participants: Owners, managers, and practitioners working in tattoo studios, body piercing establishments, beauty parlours, wellness centres, massage centres, and other personal care service establishments whose operations involve hygiene and sanitation practices, infection prevention and control measures, the use of shared equipment, close physical contact with clients, or procedures that may pose public health risks if not properly managed. This includes establishments regulated under Category IX (Other Services) of the HSRR 2025.
